Myth: The PTA is just for stay at home mums

FACT: The PTA welcomes everyone and continues to need volunteers for various events, all year round. We need you!

Myth: Volunteering for the PTA takes too much time

FACT: Only you can decide how much time you can give. Even if you help at just one event or handle one task per year, it is all greatly appreciated.

Myth: PTA volunteers need to be at the school during the day

<u>FACT</u>: Much of the work can be done on your own schedule, or at events after school or at the weekends. Yes, there is volunteering during the end of the school day, if you are able to do so. But no one does it all, so choose what works best for you.

Myth: The PTA has the same volunteers year after year and everyone knows each other

FACT: While we are fortunate enough to have dedicated volunteers who return, we need and welcome new ones every year. We are a small school and a PTA who have only been running for 4 years, the volunteers who originally set up the PTA now have children moving on to secondary schools, so new volunteers are needed to ensure we can keep the committee running.
